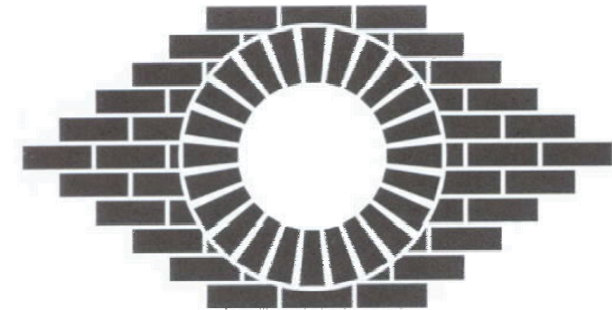
Other services within the County

What we provide:
